Qualifications: Required: MLS from an ALA-accredited institution.

Preferred: Experience providing reference service and group instruction in an academic, research or large public library. Experience developing print and/or Web-based guides for library instruction. Web experience in area of design, development or maintenance. Experience appropriate to special collections/archives positions. Working knowledge of languages in addition to English.
